Maribeth asked if we are willing to help call members. She will send us all a script and part of the list so we will all call members.

This brought up a discussion of why it is so hard to get volunteers. We are thinking maybe more events to bring people in, so they feel more a part of the club. Sarah brought up the idea of an ice cream/Pop Fizz social at the August show. Maribeth knows of an Ice Cream Truck that goes to the pool.
