The X games at the Double Diamond venue had issues such as poor footing, parking problems.

She will pick up credit card for the next show at the Stanley Cyclone Center. This will be for the lunch pick up.

Kim will also get signed checks to Teresa to pay for the venue. They need to pay a city person upon arrival at 8 am.

Teresa will probably do the lunch pick up at the show.

Sarah reported that there are no new members. We have 73 members.

Kim shared that there will be no advertising at the State Fair Show. So Cindy is not going to make up flyers for our rated show.

Cindy has the flyer made for the Stacy Williams Clinic. She will start promoting this event.

She will meet with Leslie Carpenter next week to discuss prizes.

The microchip clinic is scheduled for the August 23rd schooling show. There are not any sign ups yet. Ideas were floated about who we could promote too to get more people. Also promote that it is a requirement to show next year.

We discussed changing the price from \$75 to \$65. This includes topical antiseptic.

The vet is charging \$180 for travel charge.

\$55 per horse and an extra \$40 if the horse needs more sedation.

It was decided to charge \$65.

1. Donating the use of the NMDA arena which is parked at CTF, including delivery and up to 3 days of usage.
2. Encouraging NMDA members to attend/compete by listing the show on our website calendar, by promoting it through NMDA email blasts and by a designation as "partner show" for NMDA end of year award purposes.
3. Encouraging NMDA members to volunteer at the show in order to ensure important positions are covered.

Amy made a motion to accept this. Cindy 2nd it. All approved.

Cel shared the Sponsorship and Community Partner Forms with the Board.

The Venue Committee went to Socorro. They said the venue was nice. It was easy to find. There were 100 stalls and about 30 more to be made. They thought it was not great for a summer venue, but other seasons would work.

The Double Diamond venue had hard footing with rocks. The parking was rough. So not a great venue for future use.

Dianne Fay passed away. She was a wonderful lady who was instrumental in bringing dressage to New Mexico. We would like to honor her memory. Ideas on how to do this were: putting a picture and tribute about her on our website. At the Awards Banquet giving an award just this year in her honor-maybe an AA High Point award.
